LINE ALERT Training Collaboration Maximizes Safety Gains in Line Crossing Excavation

The LINE ALERT Panel is a new safety product that creates a much safer process for excavating over underground lines giving the excavator operator and crew visual, one inch increment distance measurements from the line as they dig. The use of LINE ALERT significantly reduces the risks associated with line strikes. However, its effective use can only be ensured with trained and qualified workers.

Acknowledging the need for worker training, KeiBerg turned to ETI, a division of Southeast Regional College, to develop, manage and maintain these training requirements. ETI specializes in training focused on the energy and industrial sectors. The result of this collaboration is a comprehensive online training and certification program available at no charge to all users of the LINE ALERT panel.

Field workers can access the program from any internet enabled computer at any time using the unique access code they are provided with. The program is broken into five sections and each section can be taken individually. Upon successful completion of the program, the worker receives a certification card and hard hat sticker.

Generally, product vendors provide training to a limited number of people who are then expected to train others in their organization. KeiBerg believes training is essential to every individual using LINE ALERT and provides certification at no charge to everyone using the product. The company maintains that just 'One Line Strike is Too Many.' and are doing whatever they possibly can to eliminate the incidence of line strikes all together.
